24 hours a day- 7 days a week



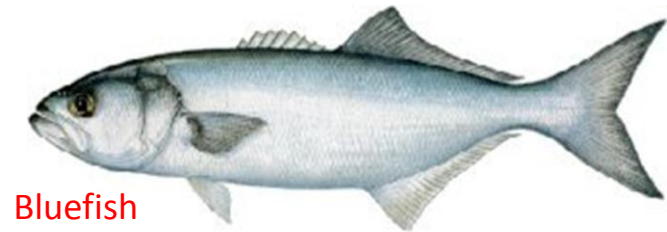
